

Spot the difference

Key Stage 2 (7-11 years)

This fun activity is linked to elements of the National Curriculum:
Personal Social Health Education (PSD and PSE).

Learning outcomes

- Make observations and recognise differences
- Make connections and see relationships
- Understand what a Macmillan nurse does

Preparing for the activity

You will need

- A photocopy of the activity sheet for each pupil
- Colouring pencils, crayons or pens
- To know how Macmillan Cancer Relief helps people living with cancer (read more in the 'Getting Involved' section of the Class Action website)

What to do

Spend time looking at the picture with your pupils, describing what is in it as well as why people may go to the hospital. Describe what Macmillan does and what a Macmillan nurse does.

After talking about the picture with your pupils, ask them to complete the sheet (spot the differences). They can also colour in the pictures.
